

NZIMA Financial Support – Report Requirements

Your report should include a summary of your research activities, details of any other researchers involved in your projects, any additional funding or other support received, and all significant publications and other outputs resulting from the scholarship. Details of subsequent publications and other outcomes should be forwarded to NZIMA at a later date.

Please include in your report the principal purpose to which your NZIMA support was used. For example:

- if the support was used to organise a conference, include details of speakers and relevance of the event to New Zealand.
- if the support was used to fund for a visitor, please describe how the grant has raised the knowledge and skills in the mathematical sciences in New Zealand.

All reports should try to justify their activity in terms of the benefit to New Zealand of the activity, and the other aims of the NZIMA (see below):

- create and sustain a critical mass of researchers in concentrations of excellence in mathematics and statistics and their applications
- provide NZ with a source of high-level quantitative expertise across a range of areas
- act as a facilitator of access to new developments internationally in the mathematical sciences, and
- raise the level of knowledge and skills in the mathematical sciences in NZ.

Reports should include an outline account of how the moneys were disbursed, and any unspent funds should be returned to NZIMA.

The suggested format is as follows:

- a) Brief title of activity
- b) Description of activity
- c) Names and affiliations of researchers involved
- d) Detail of any additional funding or other support received
- e) Publications and other outputs resulting from the activity
- f) Summary of benefits to NZ (in terms of the aims of the NZIMA)
- g) Account of how the money was used
